**Notes:** You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity. If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
