Walk description:	One of the more difficult walks, starting in the wooded terrain of Bucks Mills, taking you up and down the more challenging cliff paths of Peppercombe, Babbacombe and Green Cliff around Abbotsham cliffs, ending at Kipling Tors Car Park, Merley Road, Westward Ho!	A challenging walk for the fit and experienced walkers only. From Clovelly you will enjoy woodland walking emerging along the coastal path with spectacular cliffs and views. Challenging climbs and descents. Lunch break at Hartland Point. Joined by others for second section to Hartland Quay Hotel taking in Upright Cliff, Dyers Lookout and Broad Beach.	A delightful walk, mostly through woodland along the top of the cliffs with beautiful sea views of Lundy and the surrounding Bideford Bay.	A fun and particularly child and family friendly walk. You will be led from the coastguard station along Westward Ho! beach, around the estuary mouth to Greysands, then back to the coastguard station via the Northam Burrows County Park seeing the sheep, horses and golfers as well as the stunning scenery of the coastline and Lundy as you go!	Starting with a walk across Croyde beach, the walk becomes more arduous as you climb the cliffs out of the bay and enjoy the beautiful scenery of Baggy Point. The walk continues around the headland to then reach Putsborough Sands and Woolacombe Bay. The walk then passes along Woolacombe Down ending at Parkin Estates car park.	Following the Tarka Trail the walk starts at the old railway station which has been restored with lines and carriages. It is totally level beside the River Torridge towards its estuary, passing the Torridge bridge and Tapeley Park. The trail then passes the restored signal box by the level crossing before continuing through a tunnel to reach the car park at Instow.	Mortehoe – Bull Point – Morte Point - Mortehoe. Stunning views from Morte Point and Bull Point. You will also pass above Rockham Bay; the scene of much wrecking and smuggling in the area. There is reputedly a secret tunnel leading from the beach to underneath the Smugglers Rest Public House in Morthoe.	Breathtaking views from an area of Exmoor boasting the highest sea cliffs in mainland Britain. Free return Marks minibus back to Combe Martin

Directions to registration starting point:	From the A39 at Bucks Cross, follow the sign to Bucks Mills. The registration car park is on the right-hand side of the road above Bucks Mills.	From the A39, take the B3237 to Clovelly. Continue to Clovelly and turn right at the sign for the Visitor Centre. Park in the car park.	From the A39, take the B3237 to Clovelly. Once in village turn left into Atlantic Way towards sea front. Before cricket club turn left into Westbourne Terrace and proceed to slipway.	Take the B3231 from Braunton to Croyde. At the Croyde sign take the next right to Down End Car Park.	Follow the A39 towards Bideford or the A386 from Great Torrington. In Bideford town centre, cross the old bridge and at the mini roundabout continue across under the high railway bridge. The station is then on the right.	From the A361 from Barnstaple take the first left at Mullacott Island towards Woolacombe. Continue to turning on right signposted Mortehoe. At bottom of hill as you come into the village the car park is on the left; opposite the Post Office.	Combe Martin is on the A399 and can be accessed easily from Barnstaple via the A3230 and/or the A3123 off the A361. Kiln Car Park is situated by the Harbour beach just off the main High Street next to the Tourist Information Centre, so follow TIC signs.
