



THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

**We are excited to take you skydiving and see all your friends and family!
WE WANT TO MAKE SURE you have all the information you need!**

Before you arrive-

There are a few things we need confirmed:

- Your booking has been made, your email confirmation has been received and we have all the correct contact information for each individual Skydiving.
- As per your booking confirmation- You know what to bring on the day- Clothing, Face coverings, **Medical forms!**
- You know what your arrival time will be. **We do not specify a jump time!** We ask everyone to be aware that you should allow 3.5 Hrs to complete your skydive from your arrival time.
- **EVERYONE IS AWARE OF THE BRITISH SKYDIVING COMPULSORY 3RD PARTY INSURANCE £19.86**
- You can log in to check your booking, your details, add media, as well as update any balance due. -skydiveukltd.com/jumper-login
- please let us know if for any reason you can not complete your skydive or will need to change the date at least 2 weeks before your arrival time. There is a charge to change the date.

Hopefully, all your details are correct, your full balance has been paid through your online portal and if you would like your jump filmed or recorded you have selected a photographer to be organised for you.

If you are jumping for Charity-

Speak with the fundraising department for that Charity so they can help you with your fundraising and provided you with a bright t-shirt to show your support.

On the day!

WE WANT TO MAKE SURE you have all the information you need!

**When you arrive-
please arrive at your selected arrival time.**

You have your medical form ready either the 115a self signed or the 115b signed and stamped by a GP.

You are aware that we will take accurate height and weights on the day and the weight surcharge is £20 per stone over 15 stone.

Once we have completed your arrival times Check in process we will take the group and any spectators over to the skydiving school.

After a short explanation of the site we will take the Skydivers into their safety briefing. Spectators may find a comfy spot in either the spectators area or in our Cafe.

Once the safety brief has been completed skydivers will be able to join the spectators until they are called through to meet their instructor and get kitted up.

Once they are in the correct equipment they will be able to give a flyer with your instructors canopy colours to those who are watching.

at this point Skydivers will be waiting to board one of the next aircraft.

Spectators can purchase a landing area ticket from inside the cafe to travel out to the landing area. This means you will be able to stand close to our landing point with a life long Skydiver who has radio contact with the aircraft and can help identify your skydiver.

When we make our way back to the Skydiving school there will be an opportunity to preview your photos in the Skydiving cafe at our photo corner.

If you have selected photos as an option you can take them away on the day on a memory stick, Video will be edited and set out to you in the post.

WEATHER

THE UK HAS EXTREMELY CHANGEABLE WEATHER!

WE WILL ALWAYS TAKE SAFETY AS OUR NUMBER ONE PRIORITY.

SOMETIMES IT IS POSSIBLE TO BE ON A SHORT WEATHER HOLD BUT WE HOPE TO COMPLETE YOUR JUMP WITHIN THE STATED 3.5HRS.

IF FOR ANY REASON IT TAKES LONGER THAN THIS ALLOTTED TIME YOU MAY SPEAK TO A STAFF MEMBER TO REBOOK.

FAQ- MYTH BUSTERS

- **Is it a heavy landing?**

Our instructors are fantastic and we specifically land on our bums because it is a controlled and soft way to land.

- **What if I am sick or wet my self?**

Because of the nature of freefall your body will be tense for about 1 minute. It is very difficult for your body to be relaxed enough to wee.

- **Who will I be strapped to?**

Our instructors are part of what makes us great! they are extremely experienced, kind people that understand the reasons you might be doing a skydive.

- **Will I fall like a sack of spuds?**

If you have seen finding Nemo.. its much like turtles in the OAC. The air supports you and you feel like you have a cushion of air beneath you.

- **What do I wear?**

Comfortable clothes :) Active clothing or anything you would be happy walking in.
As long as you can tie on your shoes and you dont have a hood.

- **Will I die?**

Its very! unlikely.... our instructors have completed between 10 and 16 thousand jumps. It is remarkably safer than many other forms of travel statistically.

- **How many jump at one time?**

We have a large aircraft that can take a total of 18 people, this usally means about 4-5 tandem students.

- **Can my family watch me?**

We have two cafe's, a spectators viewpoint and you can get a trailer ride out into the airfield to the landing zone.

- **Should I eat before?**

Yes, Have a normal breakfast, do your normal routine.

- **I wear glasses, Can I wear them to jump?**

Yes, we have over google that specificly go over glasses.

- **I am scared of heights!?**

Jumping from the highest height in the UK, Is the easiest height to jump from!
Having 60 secs freefall gives your mind enough time to enjoy the experience and the views!
Completing a skydive is an excellent way to conquer your fears!
