Terms and Conditions – Nightwalk 2025

Event Rules & Guidelines

The following event rules and guidelines are intended to help produce and direct a largescale event, to ensure the safety of all participants and to meet the requirements of local government permits.

- All entry fees for Nightwalk are non-refundable, and North Devon Hospice retains the right to refuse entry to anyone declaring false information on their registration form, not making the required payment, or otherwise failing to meet the stated entry requirements.
- An email address is required for all entries. All correspondence will be via email. A separate email address for each participant is preferred but not required. Each entrant is automatically signed up for the event related communications, which includes fundraising advice and event information.
- By registering and taking part, you understand that this walk is not a race and walking along public roadways and footpaths at night is potentially hazardous. All participants take part at their own risk, North Devon Hospice and any party acting on its behalf, is not liable for any injury or loss that may occur as a result of participation.
- By participating, all participants confirm that they are happy for any footage or photographs taken during their participation to be used to publicise North Devon Hospice events.
- All participants must provide their full name and details of any health problems or medication upon registration.
- All entry fees are non-refundable and may not be deferred toward a future event unless the organisers, North Devon Hospice, cancel the event for any reason.
- Registration closure is determined and announced when event participation reaches the established capacity.
- No postal entries.
- Participants must follow instructions from all event officials, including hospice staff, volunteers, and medical personnel, throughout the duration of the event.
- All participants are expected to conduct themselves professionally and courteously during the event. This means, for example, that urinating or defecating anywhere on or near the course is strictly prohibited except in toilet

facilities. Anyone violating this rule of conduct will be disqualified from the event and asked to leave the course.

- Every participant shall be provided with a race number which contains a timing chip. No participant shall be permitted to participate in the event without their allocated timing chip.
- All participants must acknowledge and agree that personal information (including medical information entered on registration or collected by event medical staff during or after the event) can be stored, used and disclosed by North Devon Hospice in connection with the organisation, promotion and administration of the event and for the compilation of statistical information.
- Medical personnel authorized by the event to do so may examine any participant who appears in distress. If, in the sole opinion of authorised medical personnel, it is in the best interest of the participant's health and welfare, medical personnel may remove the participant from the event.
- North Devon Hospice reserve the right to delay, cancel, or suspend the event due to inclement weather following emergency protocol on severe emergencies and/or inclement weather. No refund will be issued in these circumstances.
- The organiser has no liability for any loss of travel or accommodation costs that the participant may incur.

Privacy Policy

- All customers agree to our privacy policy when they enter this event.
- By entering Nightwalk, you agree that your name and any medical conditions will be passed onto our medical provider.
- By entering Nightwalk, your name and details will be shared with our Timing Chip company for the purpose of generating your race number.

Exception

• Any individual requesting a waiver of these rules from the event shall submit a written request no less than 30 days before the event date, specifying the nature and reasons for the request.

Amendments / Reservations / Acknowledgements

- Event officials reserve the right to modify, supplement or waive all or part of the event rules.
- Participants shall be bound by any modification or supplement of the event rules published before the event.

• Failure to follow these event rules, as may be amended, will result in immediate disqualification.

Disclaimer

All participants in Nightwalk 2025, agree to the following disclaimer and the terms & conditions by registering for the event:

"I declare I will abide by the age limits set for the event and the rules set out. I declare that I will not compete in the event unless I am medically fit on the day of the walk and that, in any event, I will compete at my own risk. I accept that the organisers, sponsors, partners, and marshals will not be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses that may arise due to my participation in the event. I also hereby give my permission to North Devon Hospice to use my name, quotes, video and photographic likeness for marketing and promotional purposes. I also understand that entry fees are non-refundable under any circumstances. I also agree to the terms and conditions before I participate in the North Devon Hospice Nightwalk event."
