Terms and Conditions - Buckland Brewer 10K

Event Rules & Guidelines

The following event rules and guidelines are intended to help produce and direct a large-scale event, to ensure the safety of all participants and to meet the requirements of local government permits.

This event is jointly organised by Will Slocombe and North Devon Hospice.

All entry fees are non-refundable, and North Devon Hospice retains the right to refuse entry to anyone declaring false information on their entry form, not making the required payment, or otherwise failing to meet the stated entry requirements.

Participation

- 1. Each entrant/ runner is responsible for providing the correct, required information within the online entry form and each runner intending to take part, must register individually, with a unique email address.
- 2. An email address is required for all entries. All correspondence will be via email. A separate email address for each participant is required.
- 3. All participants must provide their full name and details of any health problems or medication upon registration.
- 4. Each entrant is automatically signed up for the event related communications, which includes training plans and event information. Entrants can opt out of further marketing emails when they register or at anytime by clicking unsubscribe at the bottom of our emails
- 5. Runners must be 16 and over to run unaccompanied. Anyone under 16 must be accompanied by an adult (over 18) and run at their own risk.
- 6. North Devon Hospice cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss to participants personal belongings, items of clothing, shoes, equipment or vehicles.
- 7. All participants take part at their own risk. In no event shall North Devon Hospice be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever, including indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential losses connected with any aspects of this event.
- 8. Photographs and video footage will be taken during the event and may be used to publicise this event and the work of North Devon Hospice.
- 9. Your registration fee is a direct donation to North Devon Hospice and due to this being a charity event, we are unable to offer refunds and transfers of race entries

- are strictly prohibited and will result in the disqualification and/or banning of any individuals involved from future events.
- 10. Any sponsorship money collected in respect to fundraising efforts is paid directly to North Devon Hospice within 3 months of the event day. If I am unable to take part in the event, all sponsorship money will be treated as a donation to the charity.
- 11. All entry fees are non-refundable and may not be deferred toward a future event unless the organisers cancel the event for any reason.
- 12. Registration closure is determined and announced when event participation reaches the established capacity.
- 13. No postal entries.

Event Day

- 1. Participants must follow instructions from all event officials, including race staff, volunteers, and medical personnel, throughout the duration of the event.
- All participants are expected to conduct themselves professionally and courteously during the event. This means, for example, that urinating or defecating anywhere on or near the course is strictly prohibited except in toilet facilities. Anyone violating this rule of conduct will be disqualified from the event and asked to leave the course.
- 3. All participants must acknowledge and agree that personal information (including medical information entered on registration or collected by event medical staff during or after the event) can be stored, used and disclosed by North Devon Hospice in connection with the organisation, promotion and administration of the event and for the compilation of statistical information.

Course Monitoring

- 1. This is an open road race and therefore any participant who refuses to obey the directions of the event official, or course marshal, or who conducts himself/herself in an unsportsmanlike manner, or who is offensive by action or language to officials, volunteers, participants or spectators may be disqualified from the event and banned from future participation in any North Devon Hospice events.
- 2. Any participant who has been found by a course marshal or event official, to have gained an unfair advantage by intentionally shortening the route of the race ("cutting the course") shall be immediately disqualified from the event and may be banned from future participation in any North Devon Hospice events.

- 3. Participants are responsible for recognising and understanding event signage, symbols and colours relating to participant maps, facilities and directions.
- 4. Medical personnel authorized by the event to do so may examine any participant who appears in distress. If, in the sole opinion of authorised medical personnel, it is in the best interest of the participant's health and welfare, medical personnel may remove the participant from the event.
- 5. Participants must immediately retire from the race if ordered to do so by a member of the event's official staff, official medical staff, or any governmental authority, including fire and police officers.
- 6. Participants are responsible and assume liability for any and all medical expenses incurred as a result of training for and/or participating in the event, including, but not limited to, ambulance transport, hospital stays, physician and pharmaceutical goods and services.
- 7. North Devon Hospice reserve the right to delay, cancel, or suspend the race due to inclement weather following emergency protocol on severe emergencies and/or inclement weather. No refund will be issued in these circumstances.
- 8. No refund will be issued if the event is cancelled due to a designated infectious or communicable disease or a threat or fear leading to quarantine, travel advisory, or warning.
- 9. The organiser has no liability for any loss of travel or accommodation costs that the runner may incur.

Privacy Policy

1. All customers agree to our privacy policy when they enter an event.

Exception

1. Any individual requesting a waiver of these rules from the event shall submit a written request no less than 30 days before the event date, specifying the nature and reasons for the request.

Amendments / Reservations / Acknowledgements

- 1. Event officials reserve the right to modify, supplement or waive all or part of the event rules.
- 2. Participants shall be bound by any modification or supplement of the event rules published before the event.
- 3. Failure to follow these event rules, as may be amended, will result in immediate disqualification.

Disclaimer

To run the Buckland Brewer 10K event, runners agree to the following disclaimer and the terms & conditions:

"I declare I will abide by the age limits set for the event and the race rules set out. I declare that I will not compete in the race unless I am medically fit on the day of the race and that, in any event, I will compete at my own risk. I accept that the organisers, sponsors, partners, and marshals will not be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses that may arise due to my participation in the event. I also hereby give my permission to North Devon Hospice to use my name, quotes, video and photographic likeness for marketing and promotional purposes. I also understand that entry fees are non-refundable under any circumstances. I also agree to the terms and conditions before I run the Buckland Brewer 10K event."
